



Monitoring the Impact of COVID-19

Introduction

Groundswell are delivering research to explore the impact of COVID-19 on people experiencing homelessness. The research aims to ensure the voices of people who are homeless are heard and are utilised to inform the ongoing response to COVID-19 both locally and nationally. As we enter the winter months and into a new national lockdown, it is vitally important that we continue to understand how COVID-19 is impacting people experiencing homelessness. The project is being funded by the National Lottery Community Fund and NHS England and will directly inform the NHS response to COVID-19 for people who are homeless. Who are Groundswell?

Groundswell is a registered charity, which exists to enable people experiencing homelessness to take more control of their lives, have a greater influence on services and have a full role in our community. We believe that the only way to tackle homelessness is with the full involvement of people who have been homeless themselves.

How can you be involved?

We want to hear first-hand what is happening to people who are homeless or have been homeless during COVID-19. There are a number of ways to be involved including:

- **Telephone interviews.** Doing a telephone interview with one of our research team over the phone. Participants will be asked a series of questions to help understand what is happening for them. Participants will receive a £10 shopping voucher as a thank you for their time.
- **Become a mobile reporter.** We can offer training and support to participants to report on what is happening in their local community. Training will be delivered remotely through mobile phones. Participants will be assigned a mentor through the process. Out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed.



How can you get involved?

- People working with potential participants can ask for consent to share details of participants with Groundswell. There is a standardized referral spreadsheet that can be used for sharing participant details.
