HC2 certificates for people with low or no income

What is a HC2 certificate?

If you apply to the NHS Low Income Scheme and receive a HC2 certificate for full help with health costs, you're entitled to: free NHS prescriptions, free NHS dental treatment, free NHS sight tests, and help with the cost of glasses or contact lenses.

Who can get one?

People who have low or no income are eligible to apply for a HC2 certificate to help with health costs, regardless of their nationality and/or immigration status.
